## To All Customers:

Please help keep our customers and youth and adult players safe by following the rules that we have implemented for all rink events.

- If your child is not feeling well, do NOT bring him/her to the rink to skate with other players.
- No handshaking, on or off the ice.
- Frequent handwashing is essential. Several hand sanitizer stations are also located throughout the rink lobby.
- Bring your own water bottle and do not share with others.
- Wear face masks inside the rink in all areas except when skating on the ice.
- Players should come dressed in their equipment as much as possible to avoid crowding the dressing rooms.
- In order to limit the amount of people gathering inside the rink as much as possible, please follow these guidelines:
  - Only one spectator should come with players. All spectators should preferably watch from <u>inside</u> the rink in the bleachers at a six-foot distance with masks on. Any balcony viewing should also be at a safe distance.
    Remember that Live Barn is available for other family members to watch games from home.
  - Before and after games/practices, do not linger in the locker rooms or lobby to socialize. Parents should wait for older players outside.
- Bar is open but food must also be purchased with all alcohol sales at this time.
